

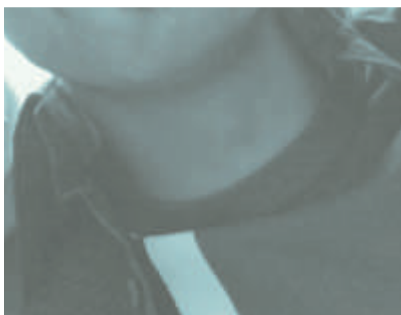
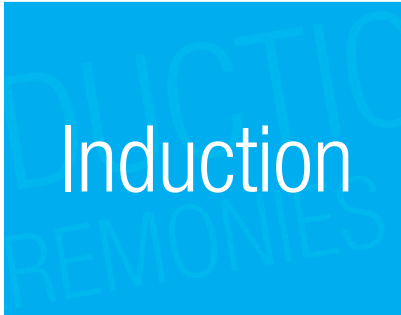

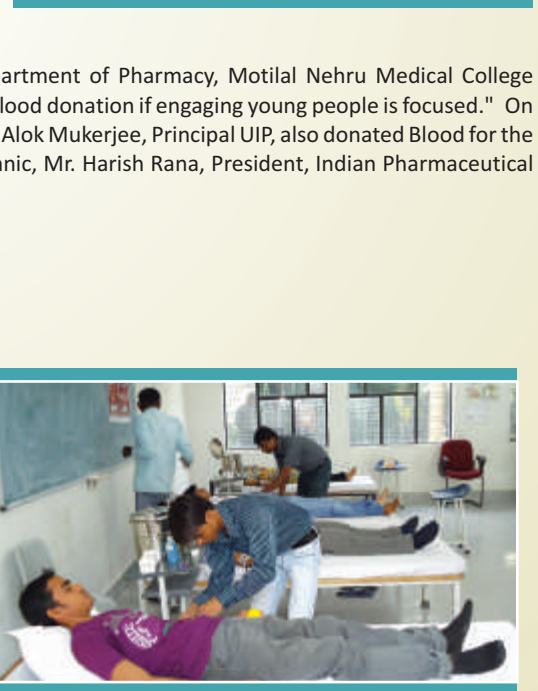
## Tree Plantation Drive November 2, 2011

<b>BOSCH</b>	22nd October, 2011	The eligible students were from Mechanical Department only as per the criteria and were required to appear for a written test followed by Technical and HR interviews.
<b>MAHINDRA &amp; MAHINDRA</b>	10th November, 2011	UGI provided this opportunity to the scholars from Mechanical Engineering and Electrical and Electronics Engineering to be recruited as GETs at 4.75 lacs per annum. Total 50 students were eligible for the process which took place on 10th Nov.2011.
<b>INDIAN ARMY</b>	19th November, 2011	In order to encourage the youth to join armed forces, INDIAN ARMY came as recruiter not only for the scholars of final year but also for pre-final year students. A final merit list was prepared for the future SSB interviews to be held in the month of June 2012.
<b>SYNTEL TECHNOLOGIES</b>	20th November, 2011	The students were required to login on to the portal and were required to answer 45 questions to qualify the written phase. 15 scholars were finally selected for the next level of interviews.
